

DAEINA Meeting 2025 – Invitation and Call for Papers

The 10th annual meeting of Danish Academic Economists in North America (DAEiNA) will be held on Saturday **May 17**, **2025** in Copenhagen, Denmark. As usual the meeting will consist of a full day of presentations, an organizational meeting as well as networking sessions over lunch, coffee and dinner. In addition, we will have an informal welcome dinner the day before (Friday May 16).

Submissions for potential presentations will be accepted from now until the conference, but we will follow a "first come, first potential accept" strategy, where we will accept papers along the way until the program has been filled. We seek to highlight work by younger scholars – especially students close to going on the academic job market. Good papers by senior scholars can also be included however.
